Alton Baker Park	Pre's trail and other bark running trails. Variety of habitats, north side of Willamette River.	Self-led run or walk
Amazon Park	Bark running trails. Restored wet prairie. Ash forest. Amazon Creek! https://www.eugene-or.gov/DocumentCenter/View/62309/North-and-South-Amazon-Running-Trail	Self-led run or walk
Hendricks Park	Beautiful rhododendron garden in Oregon White Oaks; native gardens; forest trails. https://www.eugene-or.gov/DocumentCenter/View/3447/Hendricks-Park-Map?bidId=	Self-led walk or hike
Laurelwood Bog	A 13-year-old native planting project which is now mature and has over 100 species. It is open 7 days a week during daylight hours. Go south on Agate St. from Franklin Blvd. to the 2600 block of Agate and park. Walk up (south) to the dead-end of Agate at 28th, and look for the "To the Bog" sign on a tree on the right.	Self-led walk.
Mount Pisgah Arboretum	A bit farther to drive to, but still close! Wonderful hikes. See: https://mountpisgaharboretum.org/visit/trail-maps/	Self-led walk or hike
Riverfront Bike Path	Paved 11-mile loop along the Willamette, with several bridge shortcuts.	Self-led bike or walk
Skinner Butte	Paved strolls. Views out over town in all directions.	Self-led bike, walk
Spencer Butte	Exhilarating hike with both forest and rocky site plants; amazing views. Recommend N side loop or short top loop; close to Wildcraft Cider.	Self-led walk
Trillium Gardens	Commercial (usually wholesale; some retail) native plant nursery 12 minutes from downtown Eugene. Owner present, 34610 Hwy. 58	Self-led walk; 1-5 Friday only.
