BRING

- Hand lenses, binoculars (for scoping out cliffs, etc.), cell phones.
- Wildflower apps, plant lists, maps, etc. on cell phones (or cameras and hard copies/books).
- All the usual stuff: a day pack with hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, mosquito repellent, water, snacks, first aid kit, rain jacket and warm layers, etc.
- Before the meeting, check the weather.
- Hiking poles, if desired (recommended).

Carpool from the venue and pay driver for gas; participants will arrange this at start of each field trip. Take lots of pictures!
